Foundation Year: Early 1900s

Already at the end of the nineteenth century, our family saw in the pleasant hills of Valdobbiadene, the ideal place to cultivate *vitis vinifera*, with which to produce Prosecco, now known worldwide as Prosecco di Valdobbiadene DOCG. The passion for the cultivation of vines was so engaging that it tied in an inseparable way my ancestors to the value of the best lands for the cultivation of this noble plant. Since the early years of the '900 our productions received certificates of quality of our products, one of which, delivered in 1936, has come down to us.
